A dashboard for the community has been established to track case counts in children and staff.

WHAT ABOUT THE TEACHERS AND STAFF?

- STAFF MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY HOME WHEN ILL AND THE CULTURE ENCOURAGES IT
- TESTING IS REQUIRED WHEN STAFF ARE SYMPTOMATIC BEFORE THEY RETURN TO HK
- PCR TESTING AVAILABLE ON CAMPUS AND ANTIGEN TESTS THROUGH HEALTH INSURANCE AT NO COST
- REGULAR ASSESSMENT OF PERSONAL RISK IS ENCOURAGED AND MODELED
- MASKING IS ENCOURAGED AFTER TRAVEL, ATTENDANCE AT LARGE INDOOR EVENTS, OR ENGAGEMENT IN OTHER POTENTIALLY RISKY BEHAVIORS
- TEACHERS AND STAFF FLOATING BETWEEN CLASSROOMS ARE REQUIRED TO CONTINUE MASKING
